Eligibility

- Day students that have completed their first year of legal studies are eligible to participate in a clinic.
- Evening students that have completed their first two (2) years of legal studies are eligible to participate in a clinic.
- Day Part-Time students that have completed their first two (2) years of legal studies are eligible to participate in a clinic
- Special Part-Time students are eligible to participate in a clinic during their second to last year of school.

Senior Only Clinics: Criminal Procedure II Clinic and other placements in the Criminal Law field are limited by court rule to students in their final year of law school.

Pre/Co-Requisites

Students must have either successfully completed or be enrolled in the pre/co-requisite in order to take the clinic. Please reference the Pre/Co-Requisite section of Clinic Registration Manual for additional information.

Please Note: If you are signed up for a clinic but waitlisted in the pre/co-requisite, you have until the end of the Add/Drop period to enroll in the pre/co-requisite; otherwise you will be ineligible to enroll in the clinic.

Clinic Registration Process

Online registration is not available for clinics. Students must submit a signed clinic registration form to the Registrar's Office during the appointed registration time. The registration form is available on the Registrar's Office Forms webpage under PDF Forms.

Clinic Registration Process Form Submission Requirements

- **Signed Clinic Registration Forms:** Students must submit a signed clinic registration form to the Registrar's Office during set registration time. **Students who submit unsigned clinic forms will not be eligible for clinic registration.**
- **Clinic Registration Form Submission Limit:** **Students can only sign up for one (1) clinic at a time.** If you are waitlisted, then you may sign up for another clinic pending approval from the Director of Clinical Programs.

Results

Clinic results will be made available the Monday or Tuesday after the clinic registration dates. The results are posted on NECIN, the Registrar's Office bulletin board on the 3rd floor of the Stuart Street building and in the Registrar's Office at the Church Street building.

Additional Registration Information

Students are automatically registered for the 2-credit option for clinics. At the first clinic meeting of the semester, students can receive an approval form from the Director of Clinical Programs to enroll in the 3 credit clinic. The form – once signed by the Director of Clinical Programs – must be returned to the Registrar's Office.

Late clinic registration will be permitted if space is available and with approval from the Director of Clinical Programs.
