Instructions: New England Law | Boston

We accept applications that have been prepared using the Law School Admission Council's electronic application. This service allows you to use your computer to efficiently fill out applications for all ABA-approved law schools.

There are two ways to apply using LSAC's electronic application:

1. You can use the electronic application to transmit your law school application to LSAC. LSAC will then send both the printed and electronic versions of your application to our office. Do not send an additional application by mail. If you would like to apply to more than one division using this method, please mark only one division and submit the application online. Your credit card will be charged for this first division. Then, send us a letter indicating the additional divisions desired along with a check for the additional fees (\$65 for each division). Applications submitted to LSAC for transmission to this law school will be considered postmarked on the day they are electronically submitted.
2. You can print out your completed application and send it directly to this law school at the address indicated. If you would like to apply to more than one division using this method, please mark the boxes for each division desired on the printed copy. Sign the application form and mail it to us with a check for the total amount due (\$65 for each division).
