**Subject:** Emergency Funds Available

To All New England Law | Boston Students:

In spring and fall 2020 semesters, New England Law was allocated funds from the CARES Act to be used to support students and higher education institutions with expenses and financial needs related to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Since the pandemic continues to affect many individuals and families across the nation, the US government has allocated schools additional funds to pass along to students. We realize that students may continue to encounter acute financial challenges during the semester and for this reason, we are again offering emergency financial grants to students.

If you continue to experience financial hardship directly related to the COVID-19 health emergency and/or the resulting transition to remote learning, you may apply for emergency relief funds. All applications will be evaluated with consideration of such factors as financial need, the nature and extent of the acute financial emergency and its relationship to the pandemic. The pool of funds is limited, and applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis until all funds are disbursed.
