

# NEW ENGLAND LAW | BOSTON EMERGENCY FUND APPLICATION

The New England Law | Boston Emergency Fund is available to provide limited financial assistance to enrolled students who are unable to meet immediate, essential expenses because of temporary hardship caused by the COVID-19 emergency. We have a limited amount of funds to provide financial assistance to students (both current and matriculating in the fall 2020 semester) who are unable to meet essential technology expenses because of hardship caused by COVID-19. The priority deadline for application submissions is September 4, 2020. All applications must be submitted by e-mail to [emergencytechfund@nesl.edu](mailto:emergencytechfund@nesl.edu).

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be enrolled for the fall 2020 semester and have financial hardship caused by the COVID-19 emergency. Applicants must demonstrate that the financial need is a one-time need pertaining to the move to online instruction, rather than a chronic financial need. In assessing your need for emergency assistance, please consider the following guidelines regarding minimum technology requirements:

- Access to a **computer** (Apple or PC)
- A **microphone** (either built-in to the computer or USB)
- A **camera** (built-in or USB webcam)
- **Internet access** – Broadband wired or wireless (3G or 4G/LTE). Minimum bandwidth is 600Kbps (up/down) and recommended is 1.5 Mbps (up/down).
