Information for Graduating Students:

Integrated Bar Readiness Fee (assessed each semester of final year): \$225

Graduation Fee (assessed final semester): \$170

Bar Exam Fee Borrowing Allowance: \$1,040

In your final year of attendance, your Cost of Attendance will include an additional amount to cover the cost of the bar exam fees. For the 2024-25 academic year, that amount is \$1,040. If you are planning to sit for a Bar exam that is more expensive, you may elect to have your Cost of Attendance increased to reflect those fees.
