NOTE: for students enrolled in the **flexible JD program** and enrolled in less than 8 credits, you will be assessed tuition at the per credit rate of \$2,752. Enrolled in 8-12 credits = evening tuition rate, and 13-15 credits = day tuition rate.

Student Health Insurance: TDB

Students who enroll in the student offered health insurance can request that their 9-month student expense budget be increased to reflect this cost.

Information for Graduating Students:

Integrated Bar Readiness Fee (assessed each semester of final year): \$240

Graduation Fee (assessed final semester): \$170

Bar Exam Fee Borrowing Allowance: \$1,040

In your final year of attendance, your Cost of Attendance will include an additional amount to cover the cost of the bar exam fees. For the 2026-27 academic year, that amount is \$1,040. If you are planning to sit for a Bar exam that is more expensive, you may elect to have your Cost of Attendance increased to reflect those fees.
